New Assisted Living Expansion Opens at The Forum's On-site Health Care Center

Residents of The Forum retirement community, city officials and Cupertino Chamber of Commerce representatives recently gathered for an official ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of a 24-unit addition to the community's on-site Health Care Center for Assisted Living services.

Marian Melendy, board president of The Forum's Retirement Services, Inc., and Alan Hubbard, board president of The Forum's Retirement Housing Corporation, shared ribbon-cutting duties, while Cupertino Mayor Patrick Kwok offered congratulatory remarks. Other officials in attendance included City Council member Dolly Sandoval; Planning Commission Chair Gilbert Wong; City Manager Dave Knapp; and Chris Guisiana, CEO of the Cupertino Chamber of Commerce.

The new Assisted Living expansion at The Forum adds approximately 21,000 square feet to the existing Health Care Center and was designed by Thomas Brutting of HKI&T Architects, the same firm that designed the original buildings for The Forum, which opened in 1991.

"The overall design concept of the new building creates an environment so that the resident becomes one with nature through high ceilings, glass windows and doors, screened-in porches, numerous outdoor walkways, patios and sitting areas," said Administrator Nila Mattson. "We now have room for a cyber café, bistro services, an expanded resource library and additional activity space with designated neighborhoods to promote a homelike environment."

The new addition allows The Forum to increase capabilities

for resident members, who have first priority at the community's on-site Health Care Center as part of the continuing care plan at The Forum. The expansion will also allow The Forum to accept admission of private non-member residents in Assisted Living and short-term Medicare non-member residents for nursing and rehabilitative services when there is availability in the Health Care Center.
